III. Support to the National Sports Federations and other appropriate bodies;

IV. Strengthening of scientific and coaching support to sports;

V. Incentives to sports persons;

VI. Enhanced participation of women, tribals and rural youth;

VII. Involvement of the corporate sector in sports promotion; and VIII. Creation of greater awareness in promotion of sports.

(c) Sports Policy is already under implementation through various schemes of the Ministry.
