**Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:**

(a) whether Afro-Asian games were held in Andhra Pradesh in the recent past and some PSUs had promised to finance the same partly;

(b) if so, the name of such PSUs and details of the funds promised and released so far; and

(c) the reasons for shortfall and by when balance amount is likely to be released?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS (SHRI SUNIL DUTT)

(a) to (c): The First-Afro Asian Games were held from 24th October to 1st November, 2003 at Hyderabad. In this regard Government had approved a total budget of Rs.103.00 crores. Rs.63.00 crores were provided by the Central Government and remaining Rs.40.00 crores was to be raised by the Organising Committee by way of sponsorship and through contributions by Central PSUs. However, Government of India has supplemented the efforts of the Organising Committee by taking up the matter with various Ministries for impressing upon the PSUs under their control for making contribution for conducting the Games. As a result of these efforts, an amount of Rs.23.6 crores could be raised which includes Rs.13.66 crores contributed by Central Public Sector Undertakings as indicated in Annexure-I and Rs.9.94 crores by the marketing efforts by IOA/State Government.

The Organizing Committee and State Government of Andhra Pradesh have been requested to submit the audited accounts and Utilization Certificate for the grant of Rs.63.00 crores released by Government.
