Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Sports Authority of India (SAI) provides funds to States to organize sport competitions for the boys and girls at Block, District, State and National Level;
- (b) if so, the details of funds provided during the last three years, State-wise;
- (c) the achievements made by organizing such competitions during the said period; and
- (d) the steps taken by the Government to check the misuse of funds allotted by the SAI?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS (SHRI SUNIL DUTT)

(a) Sports Authority of India (SAI) has no schemes to provide funds to States to organise sports competitions for the boys and girls at Block, District and State levels. However, SAI implements the following schemes of the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports on agency basis under which competitions are held at block, district and State level.

- i) All India Rural Sports Tournaments (AIRST)
- ii) National Sports Festival for Women (NSFW)
- iii) North-East Sports Festival (NESF)

(b) The details of funds provided during the last three year state-wise & Scheme-wise at Annexure I.

(c) Talented trainees identified from these competitions are offered admission to following Sports Promotional Schemes being implemented by SAI :-

- i) National Sports Talent Contest Scheme (NSTC)
- ii) Army Boys Sports Company (ABSC)
- iii) Special Area Games (SAG)
- iv) SAI Training Centre (STC)
- v) Centre of Excellence (COX)

During 2003-04, sportspersons trained by above institutions have won 1026 National Awards and 197 International Awards including those of last Commonwealth Games, Asian Games& Afro-Asian Games.

(d) No case of misuse of funds has come to notice.
