## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI M.A.A. FATMI)

- (a) & (b): As mandated by the All India Council for Technical Education Act, 1987 the Council lays down norms and standards in the field of technical education and insists on their fulfilment before granting approval to technical institutions/courses to ensure quality. The process of approval includes periodic inspections, appraisal of the inspection reports and conveying the deficiencies identified to the concerned institution. The Council has taken steps to sensitize institutions to focus on quality and effected reduction of seats where deficiencies in faculty have been noticed.
- (c) & (d): The Government of Karnataka has stated that they have not given any suggestion in this regard.
