(a) to (d) No such specific proposal has been received in Central Water Commission. However, the Government of Orissa has formulated a preliminary project report for Mahanadi Basin Development Plan at estimated cost of Rs. 3493.10 crore. This project includes, inter alia, dredging of various river mouths of the Mahanadi Basin for which there is a provision of Rs. 30.00 crore in the above project report.
