(a)&(b) Yes, Sir.

(c) The Genetic Engineering Approval Committee (GEAC) set up by the Ministry of Environment and Forests under the provisions of "Manufacture, Use, Import, Export and Storage of hazardous micro-organisms/Genetically Engineered Organisms or Cells, 1989" under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 in its 33rd meeting held on 5.7.2002, decided not to accord clearance for import of Corn Soya Blend (CSB), as there was no certification from the US regulatory agency to the effect that the CSB shipment does not contain any banned or obsolete variety of transgenic corn.
