- (a) whether due to an increase in the demand of Cell Phones, the demand of land line telephones has considerably come down;
- (b) if so, the percentage of decrease in the demand of land line telephones in the country during the last three years;
- (c) whether the Government has reviewed the working of Indian Telephone Industries in different States;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken or being taken by the Government to make maximum utilization of manpower in it;
- (e) the comparative data of income of BSNL, MTNL and Videsh Sanchar Nigam through mobile service and fixed telephone service during the last two years; and
- (f) the details of the policy formulated by the Government to boost the declining popularity of land line service?

The Government has announced a revival package of Rs. 508 crore for the revival of ITI in the Budget Session 2004-05 of the Parliament. BSNL has placed purchase order for one million line of GSM equipment on ITI.
