- (f) if so, the details thereof and the names of countries where these offices are proposed to be opened?

## **Answer**

## THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF TOURISM(SMT. RENUKA CHOWDHURY)

- (a): There are 13 India Tourism Offices operating overseas at present. These are located at New York, Los Angeles, Toronto, London, Frankfurt, Paris, Amsterdam, Milan, Dubai, Johannesburg, Tokyo, Sydney and Singapore.
- (b), (c) & (d): These offices are effectively performing the required functions of promoting and marketing India as a tourist destination in the overseas markets through a range of promotional activities, which have resulted in greater visibility of the Indian tourism products in overseas markets and an increase in foreign tourist arrivals and foreign exchange earnings in the country.
- (e) & (f): A proposal for opening only Representative offices in China, South Korea and Thailand is in process.
