- (b) if so, the details of progress made so far in this regard?

(a) & (b): Oil and Natural Gas Corporation Limited (ONGC) uses microbial techniques for oil and gas prospecting. It has been using the Geo-microbial Survey Technique since 1989 and has standardized the technique which supplements other geoscientific inputs for exploratory decisions. ONGC has carried out Geomicrobial surveys in various areas of Cambay Basin, Assam-Arakan Basin, Cauvery Basin, South Rewa Basin, Himalayan foothills as well as Deep offshore sediments of Ratnagiri and Kutch-Saurashtra.

Oil India Limited (OIL) is also carrying out Geomicrobial studies for its Kashipur Petroleum Exploration Licence (PEL) areas in the Ganga Valley, through the Regional Research Laboratory, Jorhat, Assam.
