- (c): During 2004-05, 11 EDPs were conducted in Assam exclusively for women, in which 389 women entrepreneurs participated. Under the Trade Related Entrepreneurship Assistance for Development (TREAD) Scheme, an amount of Rs. 8.65 lakh has been sanctioned and released to the Indian Institute of Entrepreneurship, Guwahati for conducting training of and studies on women entrepreneurs of Assam, to assist them in setting up small scale units/income generating activities.
