(a)&(b):Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited (BPCL) has two subsidiary companies, viz., Kochi Refineries Limited (KRL) and Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL). Based on BPCL's proposal to merge KRL with itself on account of synergies in their operations and the strategic advantages in such a merger, the Government have approved the merger of KRL with BPCL. BPCL has no proposal to merge NRL with itself.
