- (b) if so, the Centre's share in this scheme;
- (c) the total estimated expenditure for the year 2005-06; and
- (d) the total estimated requirement for the year 2006-07?

- (d) The requirement of Central share for 2006-2007 is estimated at Rs.1700.00 crore.
