(a) to (d): On the basis of the media reports that the information regarding the Special Drive launched by CBI on 30.9.2005 had leaked, the CBI is conducting verification into the matter. CBI has sensitized its field formations and has instructed them to take extra precautions during mobilization of manpower/logistics for Special Drives.
