RECOGNITION TO DOMESTIC TOUR OPERATORS

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to give recognition to domestic tour operators in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the suggestions/ requests received by the Government so far from such operators?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF TOURISM (SMT. RENUKA CHOWDHURY)

- (a) and (b): With the objective to give stimulus to promotion and development of domestic tourism and to encourage high quality services, the Ministry of Tourism has launched a voluntary scheme to approve bonafide Domestic Tour Operators. Some salient conditions which must be fulfilled by the Domestic Tour Operators to receive government recognition are as follows:
- 1. the operator should have a minimum paid up capital of rupees five lakhs and a turnover of rupees twenty lakhs.
- 2. the operator should have been in operation for a minimum period of one year and have a minimum office space of $250 \, \mathrm{sq.ft.}$
- 3. the operator must employ a minimum of 4 appropriately qualified staff.
- 4. the operator should be an income tax assessee.
- 5. After recognition is granted, the operator must follow the terms and conditions laid down by the Government, from time to time
- (c): The guidelines for approval of Domestic Tour Operators have been formulated in consultation with the Travel Trade Associations.
