(a) and (b): Though there is no specific scheme for promoting tourism through Indian Embassies, promotional activities undertaken by the Indiatourism Offices overseas are in coordination with the Indian Missions abroad. Joint promotional efforts are initiated with the Embassies from time to time and support is extended to the Indian Embassies in their promotional activities related to tourism which include advertising, participation in fairs and exhibitions, organizing India seminars, workshops, food festivals and road shows, publication of brochures, joint advertising support and inviting media personalities, tour operators and opinion makers to visit the country under the Hospitality Programme of the Ministry.
