- (a): Prasar Bharati has informed that the Kisan Channel was started on 21st January, 2004 in narrowcasting mode from Daltonganj, Dibrugarh, Gulbarga, Hissar, Indore, Jalpaiguri, Muzaffarpur, Rajkot, Sambalpur, Shillong, Varanasi and Vijayawada. The agriculture programmes are being telecast from Jalpaiguri between 5.30 PM to 6.00 PM and from other Kendras between 6.00 PM to 6.30 PM.
- (b): Prasar Bharati has informed that this Channel is presently not facing either resource crunch or shortage of manpower.
