- (a) & (b) Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL) propose to lay undersea cable in partnership with Sri Lanka Telecom. Approximately 320 Kms. long cable will be laid between Tuticorin (India) and Mount Lavania (Sri Lanka).
- (c) BSNL has reported that this project is likely to be operational by June, 2006.
