- (a) whether the Government has decided to involve the Indian Institutes of Technology (IIT) and Indian Institutes of Management (IIM) to promote consumer protection in the country;

- (c) whether the Government has chalked out measures to evolve a convergent approach in consumer protection by drawing up a responsive and proactive consumer protection regime in the country;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and

(a) to (e): Consumer Protection has been identified as a thrust area for priority action by the Government. The Department has therefore decided to involve leading institutions in the country like IITs and IIMs, with a view to address major concerns of consumers in some critical areas which require technical expertise of high order. This Department has also requested all Ministries/Departments/State Governments/Industry Associations etc. to place proper mechanisms in different sectors for settlement of consumer complaints.
