(a) States which have been declared as special category states;

(b) the States which are demanding special category State status;

(c) whether thee State Government of Orissa has also made any demand for the same; and

(d) if so the steps taken to accord special category State status to Orissa?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI S.S. PALANIMANICKAM)

(a): The existing Special Category States are Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Himachal Pradesh, J&K, Manipur, Mizoram, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Sikkim, Tripura and Uttranchal.

(b) The States of Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Goa Jharkhand, Orissa and Rajasthan have demanded Special Category State Status.

(c)& (d): Yes, Sir. Orissa does not fulfill the requirement of Special Category State. Hence has not been accorded this status.
