- (a) whether the Union Government has received any proposal from certain State Governments particularly from Chhattisgarh to generate employment opportunities in urban areas under `Swarna Jayanti Shahari Rozgar Yojana`;

- (a): No such proposal under Swarna Jayanti Shahari Rozgar Yojana has been received from any State Government including the State of Chhattisgarh in the Ministry of Urban employment & Poverty Alleviation during the current year (2005-06). Under SJSRY, Central funds are tentatively allocated to the States/UTs in proportion to the incidence of urban poverty in the States/UTs and funds are released on the basis of receipt of Utilisation Certificates for the earlier releases and release of matching States shares by the States.
