- (a) collection of Indirect Taxes namely Customs duty, Central Excise duty and Service Tax are compiled commissionerate/ zone wise. Total collection of above indirect taxes during April-September, 2005 was higher than that of the corresponding period of the previous year (2004-05) by 16% (provisional).
