(a)& (b): Ministry has decided that if viable, the stretch from km 0/0 to 60/0 of National Highway-8A (Extension) leading to Mundra Port may be upgraded to 4-lane on Build-Operate-Transfer(BOT) basis at zero grant. In this regard, Government of Gujarat has been requested to carry out the feasibility study. The report is awaited. As such, it is too early to give the timeframe for the completion of the project.
