Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has revised norms for seeking affiliation to CT E and NCTE by educational institute;
- (b) if so, the details and status thereof; and
- (c) the extent to which the standard of technical and higher education will improve thereby in the country?

Answer

(a) to (c): The AICTE has revised its norms for granting approval for establishment of new technical institutes from

2006-07. The norms have been made more realistic in order to achieve further improvement in technical education. Some of the changes introduced are reduction in land requirements for certain categories of institutions/cities, increase in the requirement of built up area, relaxation in faculty cadre ratio, 'No Objection' from State Government not required etc. The details of the revised norms are available on AICTE website www.aicteernet.in

The norms and standards of the NCTE for grant of recognition to institutions for starting/conducting various teacher education courses have not yet been revised.
