- (e) if so, the details thereof; and

- (a) (c) During the visit of President Musharraf to New Delhi in April 2005, India and Pakistan decided to re-establish a train service between Munabao in Rajasthan and Khokhrapar in Pakistan by January 1, 2006. The train known as the Thar Express commenced service from 18 February 2006. Government remains fully vigilant and takes all necessary steps to safeguard India's security and national interests.
