- (a) whether the Government are likely to build-up another mode of transport in additions to metro rail to improve the traffic flow during the Commonwealth games;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether any plan is under consideration to run mono rail in Delhi;
- (d) if so, whether it would cover the whole of N.C.R.; and
- (e) if so, the details in this regard?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI AJAY MAKEN)

- (a)to(c): Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi (GNCTD) has planned a public transport network which includes about 115 km of metro, 294 km corridor of high capacity bus system, about 74 km of elevated light rail transit system and 48 km of elevated mono rail. This is proposed to be implemented in three phases over the next 15 years.
