- (a)&(b): Since inception of the Integrated Low Cost Sanitation Scheme in 1980-81 till 31.10.2005, 20.78 lakh units have been constructed and 45447 manual scavengers were liberated.
- (c): The scheme is not specifically meant for urban slums but for individual households having dry latrines or are without any toilet facility.
- (d): Does not arise.
