Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether A.P. Government has sent a proposal to the Union Government for financial and technical assistance from the Federal Republic of Germany for upgradation of Primary Health Care for clearance;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the time by which said proposal will be cleared?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. PANABAKA LAKSHMI)

(a) to (d) A project proposal for Up-gradation of leftover Hospitals and balance Primary Health Centres in Andhra Pradesh, with a cost of Rs.220 crores, was forwarded to German Government on 5.6.2002 for consideration under Indo-German Bilateral Development Cooperation. During the Indo-German Annual Consultations-2003 held on 17-18th June, 2003, the German side had indicated that they were not in favour to take up this proposal.
