**Answer**

- (a) Central Institute of English & Foreign Languages (CIEFL), Hyderabad in Andhra Pradesh is the only Institution teaching foreign languages under the administrative control of the Ministry of Human Resource Development. It has two regional centres; at Lucknow in Uttar Pradesh and Shillong in Meghalaya.
