- (a) the number of fish landing centres sanctioned in the country during the last three years and the current year, State-wise;
- (b) the number of proposals pending during 2005-06, State-wise;
- (c) the time by which these are likely to be cleared;
- (d) the funds released for the purpose during the said period, State-wise;
- (e) whether the sanctioned amount have since been released to the States;
- (f) if not, the reasons for the delay; and
- (g) the action taken thereon?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI TASLIMUDDIN)

(a): State-wise details of fish landing centres sanctioned in the country during the last three years (2002-03 to 2004-05) and current year (2005-06) are at Annexure-I.

(b) & (c): No proposal confirming techno-economic viability together with availability of land and statutory clearance for construction of new fish landing centres are pending.

(d) to (g): Central funds has been provided to the coastal State Governments for construction of the fish landing centres in instalments, based on the progress of implementation of the projects. A Statement showing the State-wise details of the funds released to the coastal State Governments for construction of fish landing centres during last three years (2002-03 to 2004-05) and current year (2005-06) is at Annexure-II.
