(a) to (d) Yes, Sir. The National Culture Fund, Set up by the Ministry of Culture by notification dated November 28, 1996 provides opportunity for individuals, NGO's and Corporate Houses to participate in the repair, upkeep and maintenance of national monuments.

The National Culture fund accepts institutions and individuals as partners of the Government in the management of the culture scenario. It is an important initiative for forging public private partnership and mobilizing extra budgetary resources for the conservation of monuments.
