(a) to (c) Most of the water resources development schemes with storage are primarily planned with the objective of storing the water during the monsoon for use during subsequent period for various purposes. A number of multi-purpose schemes for flood control, irrigation and other purposes have already been planned and implemented. This aspect is duly considered by various agencies involved with water resources development & planning.
