- (a) (b) and (c):- Airlines are free to operate to anywhere in the country subject to compliance of route dispersal guidelines issued by Government. Presently, Indian Airlines, Allianace Air, Sahara Airlines and Air Deccan are operating to/from Bhubaneshwar. Recently King Fisher Airlines had requested for allotment of two parking bays at Bhubaneshwar, which have been approved by Airports Authority of India.
