(a) to (c) Comparative table showing total telephone connections working with Government owned PSUs and Private Operators as on 31st March for the last four years and their growth rate during last three years is given below:

(d) In order to ensure increase in the Public Sector Telecom Growth, following steps have been taken:

i) Government PSUs BSNL and MTNL have targeted to provide 105 lakh telephone connectins during current year 2004-05, out of which 90% are cellular & Wireless Local Loop connections which are cost effective and preferred by customers.

ii) Cabinet has approved reimbursement of License Fee & Spectrum charges to BSNL on year to year basis during 10th Five Year Plan for meeting losses incurred by BSNL in Rural Telephony.
