- (a) whether the Union Government has received any proposals pertaining to road construction works from Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan State Governments for its approval;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the estimated cost involved therein, State-wise;
- (c) the latest position of these proposals and the time by which these proposals are likely to be cleared; and
- (d) the State-wise details of the amount allocated to various States by his Ministry under the above head during the years 2003-2004 and 2004-2005?

(a) to (c) Yes, Sir. Proposals received for construction of National Highways under National Highways (Original) i.e NH (O) works from the states of Chhattisgarh , Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan are as follows :
