Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government is aware that the Katni-Allahabad rail section has not yet been electrified;

(b) if so, the action taken thereon;

(c) whether the Government is aware that the Manikpur-Allahabad rail section still has a single line track;

(d) if so, the steps taken or proposed to be taken in order to electrify and to lay double line track there; and

(e) the time by which the above work is likely to be completed?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS(SHRI R. VELU)

(a) & (b): Yes, Sir. Due to relative priority for electrification of other high density routes, there is, at present, no proposal to electrify Katni-Allahabad railway line.

(c) Yes, Sir.

(d) The work of doubling of Manikpur Cheoki (Allahabad) has been taken up in phases. Earthwork and Bridge works are in progress.

(e) Manikpur-Kataiyerdandi is targeted for completion during 2004-05. The target for other section has not yet been fixed.
