## Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether corruption is rampant in the parcel/freight booking offices of Railway;
- (b) if so, the number of complaints received in this regard during the last two years Zone-wise; and
- (c) the number of officers found guilty on the basis of complaints and the action taken against them as on date alongwith the outcome of the action taken?

## **Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI R.VELU)

- (a) No, Sir. However, a few complaints have been received about corruption in parcel/freight booking offices of Zonal Railways.
- (b) & (c) 492 complaints were received in this regard during the last two years in various zonal railways & 266 officials including officers, who were found guilty, have been taken up under Discipline and Appeal Rules. Outcome of action taken would be known after finalisation of DAR proceeding which is time consuming and continuous process. Details of the number of complaints and officials including officers found guilty Zone-wise are given in the statement enclosed.
