## Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether certain changes have been made in the examination norms -for probationary officer's examinations by several banks;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the move has been resisted by the candidates/students; and
- (d) if so, the reaction of the Government thereto?

## **Answer**

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI S. S. PALANIMANICKAM)

- (a) & (b):- Graduation was prescribed as the minimum educational qualification for recruitment of Probationary Officers, by the Government. The Government have permitted the banks :o prescribe the minimum percentage of marks in graduation and some of the banks have prescribed a higher percentage than the pass marks in graduation as the eligibility condition.
- (c)& (d)> A few representations have been received against prescribing a higher percentage as the eligibility condition and no bank has reported any difficulty in getting sufficient number of candidates having the prescribed marks.
