## Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has a proposal to make NH-24 a six lane highway;
- (b) if so, the amount sanctioned for the project;
- (c) the portion of the NH likely to be made six lane during 2004-05 financial year; and
- (d) the steps taken in this regard?

## **Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

- (a) National Highway No. 24 extends from Delhi to Lucknow and has a length of 499 Kms. Only 5 Kms. portion of this National Highway falling in Delhi has been identified for widening to six/eight lane.
- (a) No amount has been sanctioned so far.
- (c) No portion of this NH is likely to be made six lane during the financial year 2004-2005.
- (d) The Detailed Project Report for the work has been prepared.
