(a),(b), (c)& (d):- Airports Authority of India (AAI) has a proposal for construction of an International Terminal Building with related infrastructure at Thiruvananthapuram airport at an estimated cost of Rs.245 crores in two phases. The Public Investment Board in its meeting held on 6.2.2006 recommended the proposal for consideration of the competent authority. Action has already been initiated for obtaining the approval of the competent authority (Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs) to the proposal.
