- (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) & (b): Regarding National Textile Corporation (NTC), as per the Rehabilitation Scheme approved by the Board for Industrial and Financial Reconstruction (BIFR) and the Government of India, 66 unviable mills of NTC have been closed. As regards National Jute Manufacturers Corporation (NJMC), the Government has approved an Action Plan involving Voluntary Retirement Scheme (VRS) to all the willing employees, reviving two units, namely Kinnison and Khardah in the manner to be recommended by the Board for Public Sector Enterprises (BRPSE).
- (c) & (d) : There has always been endeavour of Government to encourage labour participation in management, improvement in productivity, efficiency etc. in the mills of NTC and NJMC.
