- (a) The Schemes for promotion and development of handicrafts are Central Sector Schemes and do not envisage any direct assistance to the State Governments. These schemes are grant-in-aid schemes and are being implemented through Implementing Agencies like State Handicrafts Development Corporations/Apex Societies and NGOs, etc. However, in some proposals/projects recommendations of State Governments are also received.
- (b) to (d) The state-wise details of proposals/projects received with the recommendation of State Government for the years 2005-06 and 2006-07, the action taken thereon, and assistance provided/to be provided is as per Annexure attached.
