## Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of licences/Letters of Intent issued to private manufacturing companies to produce Defence products since 2001;
- (b) whether recently the Government has blacklisted some of the private companies which are manufacturing Defence products;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the total amount of Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) came in the Defence sector since 2001?

## MINISTER OF STATE FOR DEFENCE PRODUCTION (RAO INDERJIT SINGH)

- (a) to (c): Since May 2001, 28 Letters of Intent/Industrial Licences have so far been issued to private manufacturing companies to produce Defence products. None of the companies which have obtained Letters of Intent/Industrial Licences for production of Defence items has been banned.
- (d) As per available records, the total amount of FDI inflow in Defence sector, under the licensing regime, during the period May 2001 to April 2006 is Rs. 0.24 crore.
