Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Air Force has formulated any scheme to modernise its fighter and carrier planes by 2015;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has taken any steps to upgrade the fighter planes including MiG-21, MiG-29, Jaguar, French Mirage-2000; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI PRANAB MUKHERJEE)

- (a) & (b): Modernization of fighter aircraft is an on-going process undertaken from time to time to meet the operational requirements of the Air Force. It would not be in the interest of national security to disclose further details.
- (c) & (d): Upgrade of MiG-21 fighter aircraft has been carried out. Upgrade of Jaguar and MiG-27 aircraft is underway at Hindustan Aeronautics Limited. The Air Force has identified aircraft including MiG-29, Mirage-2000 for upgrade during the 10th and 11th Plan periods.
