(a) to (c): As per the information available, Government of Orissa have issued an order vide Notification No. SRO-37/2004 dated 15.1.2004 for collection of 5% of net annual profit accrued in the project

(Mining Industry/ Commercial projects) for the peripheral development in the field of health, education, communication, irrigation and agriculture in the scheduled area within a radius of 50 KMs. The State Government has collected Rs. 36.43 crores as on 10.1.2006 from different mine owners and mining industries as peripheral development fund, out of which Rs. 8.90 crores has been spent on various projects.
