**Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government propose to construct multi-storeyed units for the rehabilitation of slum dwellers in various parts of the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the areas identified and the amount allocated for the same; and
- (c) the time by which the dwelling units are likely to be constructed?

**Answer**

(a)to(c): For integrated development of slums through projects for providing shelter, basic services and other related civic amenities with a view to provide utilities to the urban poor in select 63 cities a Sub-Mission on Basic Services to the Urban Poor (BSUP) has been launched as part of the Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM) on 3.12.2005. In the remaining cities/ towns an Integrated Housing & Slum Development Programme (IHSDP) has also been launched along with JNNURM. BSUP and IHSDP have subsumed Valmiki Ambedkar Awas Yojana (VAMBAY) and the National Slum Development Programme (NSDP). Both BSUP and IHSDP are demand driven programme for which States/ Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) have to submit Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) and sign Memorandum of Agreements (MoAs) committing to implement urban reforms. Construction of multi-storeyed flats for rehabilitation of slum dwellers in various parts of the country is an option for the States/Urban Local Bodies while submitting their DPRs.
