- (b) if so, the steps taken by the Government to check it;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to construct a bridge at this place;
- (d) if so, by when the work is likely to be started and the time likely to be taken in its completion;
- (e) the expenditure likely to be incurred thereon; and
- (f) in case the Government is not considering such a proposal, the reasons therefor?
