Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government of Punjab has approached Central Government to enhance the annual assistance from Rs.18 crore to Rs.40 crore for maintenance of 1430 km long National Highways in Punjab; and
- (b) if so, the Government's reaction thereto?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

- (a) The Government of Punjab has approached the Central Government to enhance the annual assistance for maintenance of National Highways entrusted to them, to Rs.40 crores.
- (b) National Highways in Punjab constitute nearly 3% length of National Highways in the country, excluding the recently declared National Highways. The Maintenance and Repairs Fund allocated to Punjab is Rs.19.09 crores, which is also nearly 3% of overall allocation of fund made to all States. Because of paucity of funds, allocation to Punjab cannot be increased to Rs.40 crores.
