- (a) and (b) The total length of Golden Quadrilateral Road Project is 5846 kilometer. The cumulative length of the road which has been four laned under this project upto July 31st, 2004 is 3038 kilometer. Works are under implementation on the balance length of 2808 kilometer. An expenditure of Rs. 17869 crores has been incurred by the Government on the Golden Quadrilateral Road Project as on 31st July, 2004.
- (c) The total length of road targeted to be constructed under the Golden Quadrilateral Road Project during the current financial year in the States of Gujarat and Maharashtra is 135 kilometer and 220 kilometer respectively.
