(a) & (b): Government of India has constituted the 2nd Administrative Reforms Commission on 31.8.2005 to prepare a detailed blueprint for revamping the public administration system. New administrative measures would be introduced based on the recommendations of the Commission. In the meantime, Government of India has decided to introduce Performance Appraisal Report system instead of Annual Confidential Reports and mandatory mid-career training programmes, initially for IAS officers. These steps will help in achieving greater accountability and in upgrading the skills of the officers.
