(a)&(b): Socio-economic development of the North Eastern Region is one of the priority concerns of the Central Government. With this objective, Special Packages have been announced for the States of the Region. The following announcements have been made by the Prime Minister for the North Eastern States:

- 1. Assam & Manipur November, 2004
- 2. Tripura October, 2005

3. Assam January, 2006

The implementation of the Packages is a continuous process involving Central Ministries and State Governments. Major infrastructure Ministries/Departments like Road Transport & Highways, Power, Water Resources, Railways, Tourism, Human Resource & Development and Health & Family Welfare have prepared estimates and time schedule for the implementation of the projects falling under their purview. The Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region has recently been given the responsibility of monitoring the progress of these packages with the line Ministries & Departments of Government for the expeditious implementation of the projects mentioned in the PM's announcements and report to PMO.
